Message of the President - Spring, 2019





World Congress agenda for FIP-IFP Delegates

FIP-IFP Annual General Meeting – Business meeting – by invitation only

"The General Meeting meets once per year in the first six months or at the time of the FIP World Congress following approval by the prior General Meeting" Section XI – ANNUAL GENERAL MEETINGS FIP-IFP Articles.

As decided by the FIP-IFP General Meeting last May 2018, the AGM will take place prior to the 2019 FIP World Congress. Two delegates per country are invited to join the meeting, others may be invited by the President. Each country is entitled to a single vote.

On the 13th November the day will start with an Open Committee meeting of the European Council of Podiatrists. This is for delegates from full member associations only. The ECP board will present the work achieved and the plans for the future.

This meeting will be followed by an Executive Meeting for FIP-IFP Member delegates only. At this working lunch, the delegates will have the opportunity to discuss pressing issues regarding the future of the Federation.

The AGM will take place from 2pm to 4:15pm.

Member organizations will be called by the President, in agreement with the Secretary General, no less than two months prior to the date of the meeting. The agenda is stipulated in the meeting call together with the registration link. The invitation is accompanied by the President's management report, the Treasurer's balance sheet for the year just ended and the Treasurer's budget forecasts.

Two delegates per country are invited to join the meetings. There is no delegate fee (this has been abolished by the Board in 2017). If an association would like to be present with more delegates, a participation fee will be asked of 30EUR. Associations can invite up to 3 additional persons.


All delegates will be invited to the welcome reception from the World Congress in the Exhibition hall on the 13th after the AGM (reception starts at 5:30pm).

Special Olympics - World Games

Thousands of Athletes and Unified Partners Were Given Vital Medical Screenings as Part of Special Olympics Healthy Athletes Program

- · Abu Dhabi 2019 breaks record for the largest number of screenings to take place at any World Games
- · 23,350 individual health screenings conducted at World Games
- · Over 7,000 pairs of shoes and 254 hearing aids were distributed to athletes for free

UAE, 9 April 2019: A record-breaking number of Special Olympics athletes from around the world, as well as unified partners and members of the local community, received free medical screenings as part of the Special Olympics Healthy Athletes program.

Held at the Abu Dhabi National Exhibition Center (ADNEC) throughout the World Games, teams of medical professionals carried out more screenings than ever before as part of the program. 23,350 individual screenings in various specialized areas such as overall fitness, weight and well-being, **podiatry**, hearing, sight and dental were conducted.

Based on the Memorandum Of Understanding the FIP-IFP and SOI collaborated regarding the Fit Feet Program. Former FIP-IFP President Carine Haemels, who's the FIP-IFP contact person regarding Special Olympics and regional Clinical Director was in Abu Dhabi to perform the FIT Feet screenings.

Over 5,000 people received screenings, including 5.027 athletes from 194 Special Olympics programs as well as 880 non-athletes, unified partners, coaches and members of the community.

"In line with our commitment to ensuring a healthy life for all, we are pleased to have been able to support Carine to be at the Games to provide athletes of determination and their delegations with valuable health information. We hope that



through our work, we can help them to lead a healthier life." says Christian Jérôme, President of the FIP-IFP.

The 2019 FIP World Congress will host a workshop where a Train the Trainer event will be organized with some Special Olympics athletes from California. The scientific committee has agreed to have a presentation on the subject as raising awareness regarding feet problems for that specific population is very important.

ENPODHE Conference

On Thursday 28th March, more than 400 podiatrists and podiatry students from Belgium and the European Union met in Brussels to participate at the 8th ENPODHE meeting, the European Network of Podiatry in Higher Education.

The differences in the scope of practice of Podiatry, education and training systems in Europe are worth examining within and beyond borders to create transparency and recognition of knowledge, qualifications and skills in the field of Podiatry.

Every year, the ENPODHE meetings bring together Podiatry teachers from each ENPODHE member university in a European city, accompanied by 2nd




year students. This year, Brussels was elected as the host city for the 8th edition. Parnasse-ISEI - Department of Podiatry (HELV) formed in 2005 with Prigogine (HELB) and the Artevelde high school of Ghent, a partnership between the various Belgian training institutions in order to share their methods of teaching podiatry. These meetings between the 3 schools will last 2 years and then the University of Saxion and Fontys in the Netherlands will join the project.

This is the first time in Belgium that an event of such a size has brought together so many professionals and students in podiatry. This is a great recognition for the profession, which remains relatively unknown to the general public in Belgium.

The European Network of Podiatry in Higher Education is a non-profit organisation providing an organisational framework, which aims to unite the podiatry educational institutions in the European region.

GREECE - Hellenic Society of Podiatrists



The Hellenic Society of Podiatrists organised one of the most important events for podiatrists in Greece, the third Hellenic conference of Podiatry. The conference, which took place between 20th and 21st of October 2018, was held at the Royal Olympic Hotel in Athens and it featured an array of great speakers from far and near and exemplary papers and presentations. It was a great opportunity for attendees to collaborate and network with speakers, podiatrists and other health care professionals and be informed of the latest in research and clinical practice with state-of-the-art workshops, panel discussions and exchange of views.

CZECH REPUBLIC - Czech Podiatry Association

Starting from 1 January 2019, thanks to the negotiations led by MUDr. Marie Součková, the former President, the Czech Podiatry Association managed to push forward the provision of support from the Prevention Fund of the General Health Insurance Company in the form of partial reimbursement of at least four procedures of machine dry pedicure per year for diabetic patients. It is the very first step taken by one of the health insurance companies which is well aware of the importance of necessary professional foot care for diabetic patients.

The Czech Podiatry Association is responsible for lifelong education of its members and foot care providers which is why it regularly organises the Podiatry Days for its members and supporters, which are met with great acclaim. A special thank you goes to Jana Výmolová, the organiser and the Chairperson of the Podiatrist Section of the Czech Podiatry Association. The current President of the Association, MUDr. Miroslav Koliba MBA, cooperates intensively with the FIP on the D-FOOT project and will very soon present the content and goal of an intensive course for our pedicurists to be held in collaboration with IKEM in Prague in line with the requirements of the D-FOOT project.



GERMANY - Verband Deutscher Podologen (VDP)

The new year 2019 started very busy for our association.

In January the national congress "Quality Conference" in Stuttgart with exhibition occurred with a surprise visit of FIP-IFP executive director Caroline Teugels, the Podiatrists also demonstrated again for their rights and had a lot of recognition, this time in Leipzig.

Secondly the minister of health is considering about reorganising the professions of healthcare providers like Physio Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Dietitian, Logopaedics/speech correction and Podiatry.



The VDP president and board have sent their views and statements and therefore participated in a large amount of meetings taken place in the capital Berlin at the ministry of health.

In addition almost all regional parliaments in Germany discuss about introducing the omission of tuition fees for podiatric education. On the whole, the VDP association was busy in visiting expert discussions and representing our professions´ situation. 
FIP-IFP NEWS
